

# Which Empire Rules?

Organize this game similar to 'Catch the Flag', but make the two teams different Ancient African Empires. You will need at least four players for this game. You will also need two different objects to represent your flag (This could be a scarf, t-shirt or even t-towel) This is a great game to play in the schoolyard or local park.

- 1) Split your friends into two teams of equal sizes.
- 2) Mark out a large grassy area with either string or chalk and place your flag at each end of this.
- 3) Each team has an area that they need to stay in. This is their territory.
- 4) The objective of the game is to steal the other group's flag without being touched by any opposing players. To capture the flag a player must enter the opponents' territory, and bring it back to their territory without being captured (tagged).
- 5) If a player is tagged, they must stand still like a statue in the place where they were caught until a teammate frees them by touching them.

The winning group is the team who gets the flag first.
