SANKOFA "Go back and get it."



Sankofa is a word, symbol and concept in the Twi language of Ghana that translates to *"go back and get it"* (san – to return; ko – to go; fa – to fetch, to seek and take).

The Sankofa is often depicted as a bird standing forward with its head looking back, carrying a precious egg in its beak. It characterizes the need to reflect on the past to build a successful future.
